

TQUK Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work Requalification (RQF)



This two day course is suitable for larger or high risk workplaces to re-qualify first aiders whose certificates are approaching expiry.

This course recaps all of the material from the Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work over 2 days. We keep our courses as up to date as possible, so if there have been any changes to the regulations or techniques, our requalification course is a great way to stay on top of them.

Our students will learn about:

- Roles and responsibilities of a first aider

- Incident assessment
- Dealing with an unconscious casualty (including CPR training)
- First aid for choking, external bleeding, shock and minor injuries
- The secondary survey
- First aid for injuries to bones, joints and muscles (including head and spinal injuries)
- Medical emergencies like sudden poisoning and anaphylaxis
- Recognition and treatment of major illnesses
